## PLANNING YOUR TRIP

- Start way in advance (at least 6 months before if not longer)
- Verify your Hometowns by finding on a Map

- Verify your hometown by finding a source in the town itself.
- Check <u>www.familysearch.org</u> to find if records have been filmed/digitized.

- Ireland National Library <u>https://registers.nli.ie/</u> has catholic church records you can find indexes for these on Ancestry and Find My Past
