GHENT CONSOLIDATED Cemetery

GHENT Cemeteries (no CC#): Located on the west side of Main Cross Street (47) just south of Ghent. This cemetery began as 3 separate cemeteries: (n to s) Scott, Masonic, and Oddfellow, laid out in side by side squares with rectangular sections. Now consolidated into one cemetery, it has retained the old layout (ie, the original lanes have not been filled in). A very large number of interments here. Second largest cemetery in Carroll County, and almost as large as the Carrollton IOOF. **TYPE:** Community. **CONDITION:** Well attended. Excellent effort all around. Minimal damage (no trees now) with the worst occurring from mowers moving or destroying footstones. **GPS:** 384403N - 850325W

The original records of these cemeteries were lost or destroyed...possibly were even in three different ledgers, with different caretakers. Bill Davis located the original plat map for the Scott Cemetery at the courthouse in the estate papers of S. G. Scott. The gates, posts, and iron fences along the front of the cemetery can give you the east-west boundaries. (Note that the three cemeteries butt each other directly and do not break at a road or walkway.) The IOOF cemetery on the south has a large, pointed iron fence. Where this turns into a rounded top and smaller fence is where the IOOF joins the Masonic Cemetery, to the west of this point you will see the utility buildings. Where the Masonic joins the Scott, the posts change design, becoming smaller. The section to the west is small in width with an 8 foot lane on either side. The section north of the fence where the Scott cemetery ends is the recent addition. The IOOF gate sign remains, the nippled posts that supported the Masonic sign also remain...what happened to the sign is unknown. The Scott Cemetery does not appear to have had a sign.

* * * * *
